SWIMMING POOL
RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all members, and are established to assure safe and sanitary operation.

1. No swimming allowed without a lifeguard on duty.
2. Lifeguard hours will be 12:00 - 7:00 Monday – Friday, 12:00 – 8:00 Saturday, Sunday & Holidays (weather permitting).
3. **All members and guests MUST SIGN IN with the lifeguard upon their arrival to the pool area.**
4. Children under 13 years of age are not permitted in the pool or pool enclosure unless accompanied by an adult (minimum 16 years of age) who shall be responsible for the child's behavior and conformance to all pool rules and regulations. Non-swimmers must be accompanied by an adult in the pool.
5. **Small children must wear “swimmy diapers” in the pool and must be under adult supervision at all times. No kiddy pools are permitted in the pool area.**
6. **A member must accompany a guest at the pool at all times.** The guest must leave the pool area when the member leaves.
7. No glassware, glass bottles or china may be brought into the pool enclosure. No eating, drinking or gum chewing in the pool. All persons are expected to use the trash containers provided.
8. No pets are permitted in the swimming pool enclosure at any time.
9. Use of toys, balls, rafts, or other items in the pool is at the discretion of the lifeguard.
10. Use of the deep-water areas of the pool is limited to individuals who can swim the width of the pool in a satisfactory manner. Qualification is at the discretion of the lifeguard and may be requested at any time.
11. No running or horseplay in any area of the pool.
12. No diving in the shallow end of the pool.
13. For your protection, we request that you do not socialize with or distract the lifeguards while they are on duty.
14. The lifeguard has the right to expel any guest or member from the pool or pool area if their actions warrant this measure. **If a child is expelled 2 days, his or her parents will be notified. If he or she is expelled a third time, a parent must accompany him or her to the pool in the future. Any disagreement with the lifeguard's decision is to be taken up with the Board.**
15. The lifeguard will be the only person to use the driveway and parking area at the pool, with the exception of handicapped residents.
16. No one except the lifeguard is allowed on the lifeguard stand.
17. **The phone is for emergency use only.**
